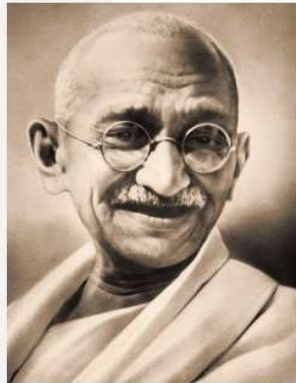

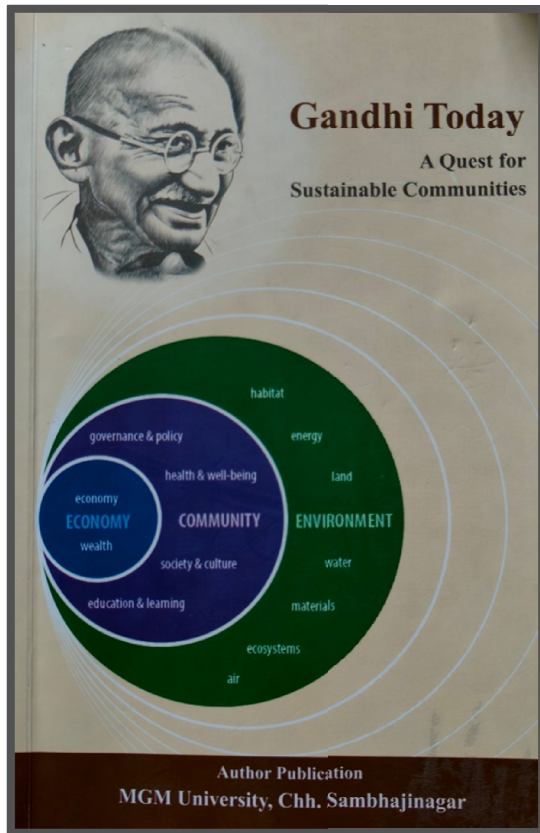
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Gandhi's Quest for Sustainable Health

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Introduction :
 "Anyone who observes the rules of health will need not knock the doors of doctors from day to day"
 Mahatma Gandhi - World Leader, motivator, visionary, environmentalist, seasoned economist, apostle of peace, campaigner of non-violence, father of a great nation, and an experimental life scientist. This is how people usually speak about this iconic persona, who conceived and pursued the ideology of Satyagraha to the world; and instrumental in bringing down the imperial power on Indian subcontinent. To be very concise, he was an institution by himself and precisely a timeless institution from the past to the present and future. Though Gandhi's role in the political arena is well known across the globe, what is less known is his immense contributions towards sustainability and health. Despite very limited resources in medical fraternity, Mahatma's approach towards health and disease management evolved around the concept of sustainability even in the era of global chaos and turmoil faced by two raging world wars. His approaches were simple, cost-effective, and benefitted several people. He had a profound interest on medicine and health. He continued to experiment with health throughout his life.
 He even once said, "It is health that is real wealth and not pieces of gold and silver." Ironically, in today's materialistic world, most of us run pillar to post to acquire wealth in young and middle age, ignoring the health. Later in old age, they keep wheeling to clinics and super specialty hospitals to recuperate from their lost health by spending their wealth. Now one can realize Gandhi's insightful words highlighting the importance of health.

Health & Eleven vows of Gandhi :
 His health concepts are very much sustainable and replicable today and even in the future. Gandhi proposed eleven vows (Ekadash Vrata) as ideals of personal and healthy living. Five of these vows, i.e., Sharishrama (Bread labour), Aswada (detachment from tasteful foods), Brahmacharya (Self-

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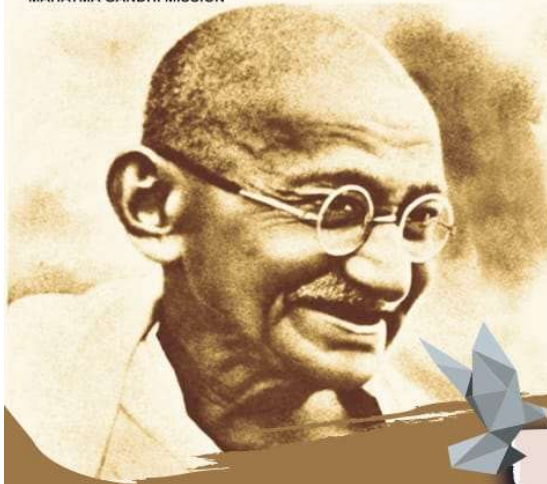
